

## WASHINGTON AREA COMPUTER USER GROUP PC DISK OF THE MONTH JUNE, 2005

The June disk contains 8 short action films that you can play on your computer. *The Hire,* from BMW Films, debuted in 2001, marking a new era in short films. Executive-produced by **David Fincher** and starring **Clive Owen**, this revolutionary series of short films brought the power and quality of feature-length movies to a format designed for the home computer.

## DAVID FINCHER EXECUTIVE PRODUCER

David Fincher entered the film industry at age 18. Within a year, he was working at Industrial Light and Magic. In 1983, he moved on to directing TV commercials and music videos. In 1987, he founded Propaganda with three other directors and has since become a successful movie director. Fincher creates films that grab the imagination and hold it captive until the final frame. An early believer in the potential of short digital films, he was instrumental in working with BMW to create *The Hire* Film Series. As Executive Producer, he contributed to the success of each film from the concept stage to the writing to the selection of directors.

**AMBUSH** On a dark freeway, a van swerves close to the driver and the door slides open. From inside, masked gunmen threaten to fire unless the driver stops and surrenders his passenger, a seemingly harmless man they accuse of smuggling diamonds. It's a simple choice: Do or die. Legendary director **John Frankenheimer** and star **Clive Owen** combine talents to create a dramatic chase with some unexpected twists.

**HOSTAGE** The driver races to locate a kidnapped victim locked in the trunk of an abandoned car somewhere on the water's edge. Linked to her only by cell phone, the driver narrows in on her location in a desperate race against time and tide. Preeminent action director John Woo and star Clive Owen pair to create this fast-paced action thriller. Running Time: 8:38 Parental Guidance Suggested. Contains mature themes.

**TICKER** The driver rescues a mysterious messenger carrying an even more mysterious briefcase after an ambush on a rural highway. As a helicopter gunman relentlessly pursues them, a game of political intrigue plays out, with an unforeseen ending. Acclaimed new director Joe Carnahan helms Clive Owen, Don Cheadle, and F. Murray. Abraham in this thrilling race against time. Running Time: 8:40. Parental Guidance Suggested. Contains mature themes.
