Background

- Windows Home Server announced by Bill Gates at the Consumer Electronics Show on January 7, 2007.
- Released to manufacturing on July 16, 2007.
- First products for sale in November 2007 (Hewlett Packard).

Specifications (cont.)

- Total of 4 internal hard drive bays
- Max Capacity: Only limited by number of internal & external disk drives
- Supports both wired and wireless PCs (via wireless router)
- Up to 10 user accounts plus “Guest”
- Headless—access via Windows Home Server Console on any attached PC

Key Functions

- Backup using Single Instance Storage
- File sharing [acts like a NAS (**N**etwork **A**ttached **S**torage)]
 - Word processing files, etc.
 - Photos
 - Music (including iTunes)
 - Videos
 - Software

Key Functions (cont.)

- Folder level security for each user
 - None: no access
 - Read: only read files
 - Full: read, write, modify, delete, etc.
- Folder level duplication across multiple disks (“RAID-1 like”, but not mirroring)

Key Functions (cont.)

- General remote access via the Internet
 - A “Windows Live ID” from Microsoft is needed to create a domain name
 - Access via User-ID & password
- Remote access to home computers via the Internet & “Remote Desktop”
 - Windows XP Professional
 - Windows Vista Ultimate, Business & Enterprise
- Printer sharing (networked printer)

Key Functions (cont.)

- Media streaming to various devices
 - Xbox 360
 - D-Link MediaLounge DSM-320 Media Player
 - Roku SoundBridge M1000 Network Music Player
 - Roku SoundBridge M2000 Network Music Player

Windows Home Server Storage

- “Drive Extender” technology
 - Drives in or attached to the server can act as a combined storage pool or as individual drives
 - Drives in the storage pool just appear as “shared folders” on each desktop (not as a lettered drive “D”, “E”, etc.)
 - Any size SATA, eSATA or USB drives can be used, i.e., mix and match

MediaSmart Server: Installation

- The installation & troubleshooting manual is quite thorough and readable
- One hour to read documentation & think
- One hour to install

— Alternatively—

MediaSmart Server: Installation

- **Don't** read documentation or think
- 3-5 hours to install

Windows Home Server Bug

- Microsoft data corruption bug:
 - Using a variety of programs to edit, transfer or save files to the Home Server (see <http://support.microsoft.com/kb/946676/en-us> for a list of the programs and details)
 - 23 programs including Outlook & Photoshop Elements
 - Impacts only servers with more than one drive
 - Backup & Restore, Health Monitoring & Remote Access not impacted
 - Fix apparently not to be available until June or later

Our Home Network

- Two HP d4996t desktop computers running Windows Vista Ultimate.
- One Dell XPS M140 laptop computer running Windows XP Media Center (SP2)
- A U.S. Robotics 8-port 10/100/1000 Mbps “Gigabit” switch
- D-Link Wireless Router
- Cat-6 cabling in the house
- ISP: Verizon FiOS 15 Mbps ↓ and 2 Mbps ↑

MediaSmart Home Server Backup

- PCs are backed up using an image-based system (VSS, **V**olume **S**hadow **S**ervices)
 - Operates at the cluster level (~4KB) and not the file level
 - A cluster is stored only once, regardless whether it comes from multiple computers
 - Single-instance storage

Frequency of Backups

- Daily/Nightly (midnight to 6:00 am)
- Backup Management
 - Set number of months to keep the first backup of the month (3)
 - Set number of weeks to keep the first backup of the week (3)
 - Set number of days to keep the first backup of the day (3)

What Happens During Backup?

- Home computers are backed up one after another in the time period set
- Windows updates are installed and Windows Home Server restarts if needed
- On Sunday “Backup Cleanup” runs

Backup: Time to Execute

Completion Time for Backups

Computer	Amount Data Stored (GB)	Initial Backup Time	Nightly Backup Time (min)
Lorrin's desktop	298	3 hrs 1 min	15.8
Ann's desktop	173	1 hr 13 min	10.1
Family laptop	35	54 min	6.5

Backup: Storage Used

- The total amount of data stored on the three computers on the network is 506 GB
- The total amount of backup storage consumed on the server is 289 GB
 - This includes complete system backups plus daily backups starting on December 24, 2007

Data Recovery

- Individual files and folders can be restored
- Entire home computer systems can be restored
 - Two restoration discs are provided:
 - Server Recover Disc
 - PC Restore Disc

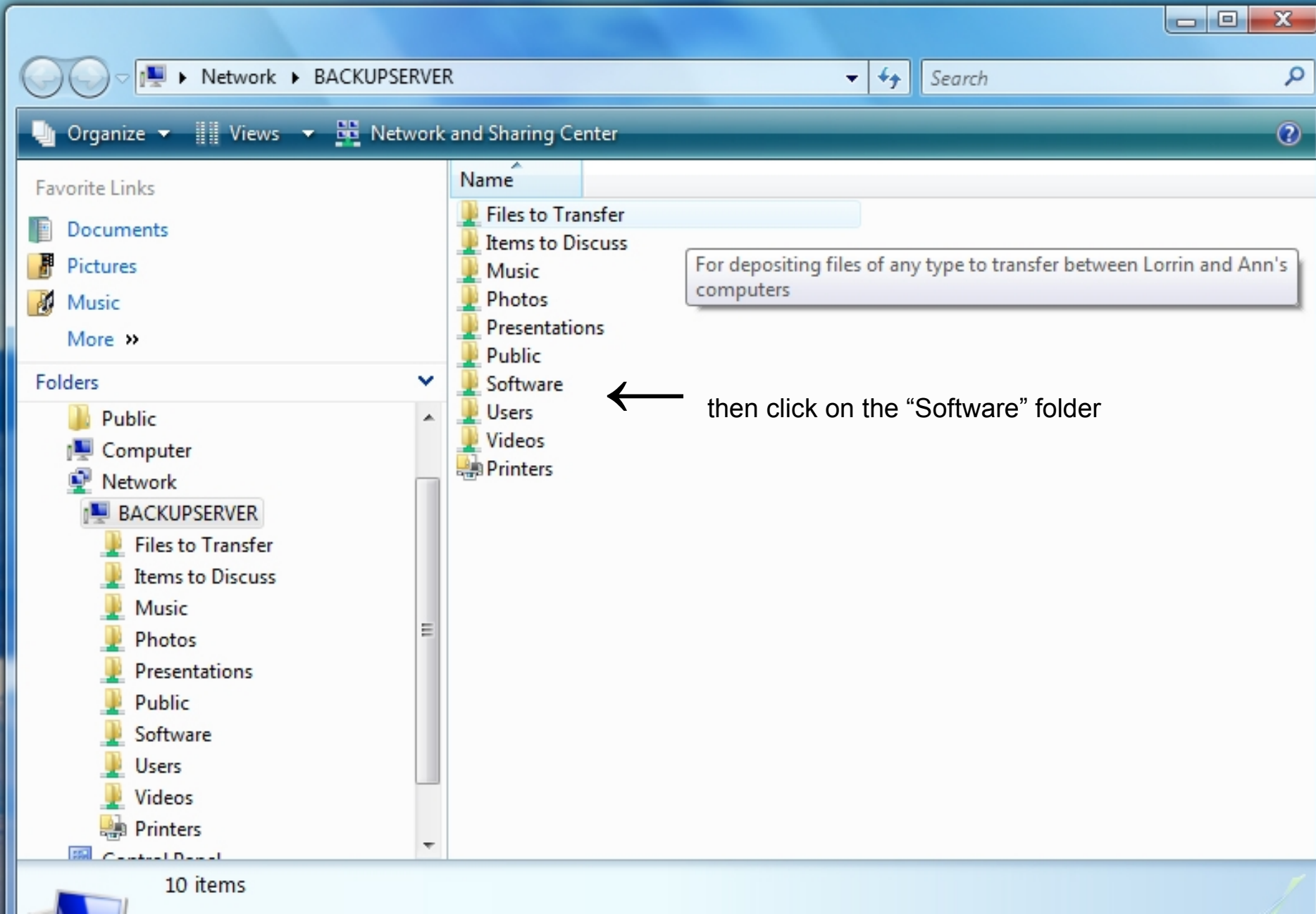

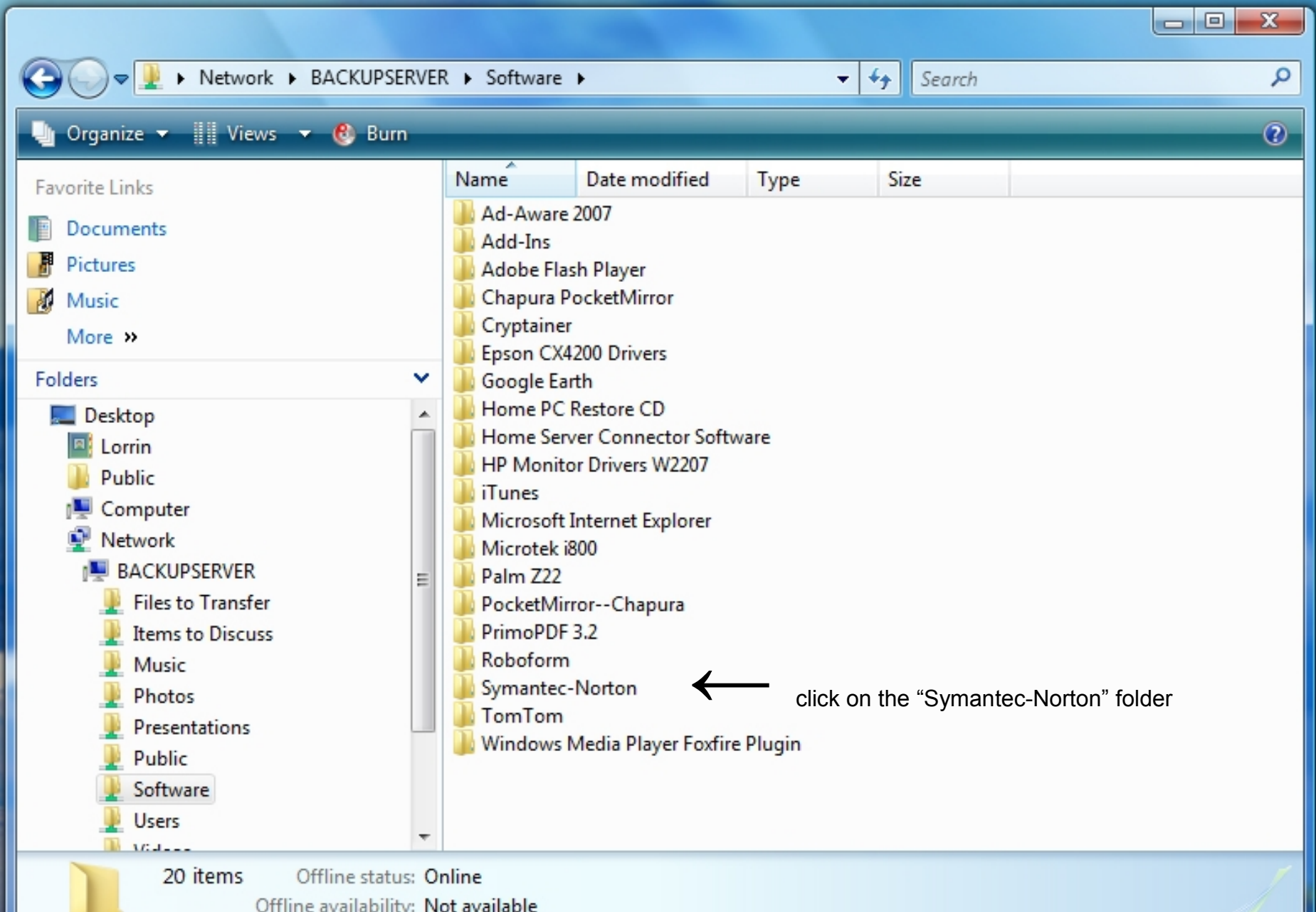
